Requirements

Applicant must be an Associate Member, Affiliate Member or SRA of the Atlanta Area Chapter Appraisal Institute in good standing, working toward an MAI or SRA designation.

Applicant must have attended a minimum of 2 Atlanta Area Chapter Appraisal Institute meetings within the past eighteen months. Please provide dates of the meetings. Please note that the attendance at continuing educational offerings (ex.: State of Atlanta, half-day educational sessions prior to the meetings, etc.) are not considered a meeting.

Applicant must submit a list of completed Appraisal Institute courses, to date.

Applicant must submit a resume or statement of qualifications. Please list most recent employment first.

Applicant is asked to list any Honors, Awards or Distinctions.

Applicant is asked to list any extracurricular activities and affiliations with other professional organizations.

Applicant is asked to list any volunteer or community service.

Applicant must state if he/she is a previous scholarship recipient of this award.

Applicant must submit a maximum 500 word written essay stating why he or she should be awarded the scholarship, highlighting professional goals and experience. In this essay, applicant should list educational plan for the MAI or SRA designation. In lieu of an essay, two questions supplied by the Scholarship Committee may be answered. Examples: Why do you want this scholarship? Please discuss your interest in residential or commercial real estate appraisal and your career objectives. Please include why you believe your interest and objectives make you uniquely qualified for this scholarship.

Applicant must provide a letter of recommendation from current or previous employer.

Conditions

Scholarships may be applied only to Appraisal Institute core courses offered by the Atlanta Area Chapter Appraisal Institute and that are provided to qualify an individual for the MAI or SRA designation. Scholarship money will be paid directly to the course provider. Scholarship money is for course fee only. Scholarship award must be used within the 18 months following its award date.

Only one scholarship may be awarded to an individual in any one award period. There is a limit of two annual consecutive awards for any individual.

Award recipients must submit either a course registration or written correspondence to the Chapter Executive Director stating his/her intention to attend the course, no later than 30 days before the start date of the intended course.

Deadline to submit application is September 30 of each year. The scholarships will be awarded on November 1 of each year. Persons awarded the scholarship may be asked to attend the next Chapter meeting (held in Atlanta) following the award date for the formal presentation announcement.

A photograph of the Applicant may be requested for publicity and promotional uses in the Chapter newsletter or AI National correspondence.

Applicant will be notified by letter or email if a scholarship has or has not been awarded.
