Requirements

Applicant must be an Associate Member/Affiliate Member/SRA of the Atlanta Chapter of the Appraisal Institute in good standing, working toward an MAI or SRA designation.

Applicant must have attended a minimum of 2 (two) Atlanta Chapter of the Appraisal Institute meetings within the past 18 (eighteen) months.

Applicant must submit a list of completed Appraisal Institute courses, to date.

Applicant must submit a resume or statement of qualifications. Please list most recent employment first.

Applicant must state if he/she is a previous scholarship recipient of this award. If so, state which core course was taken.

Applicant must provide a letter of recommendation from current or previous employer, or from another professional.

Requirements Continued

Applicant must submit a maximum 1000 word written essay addressing the following two topics:

- 1) Discuss your interest in residential or commercial real estate appraisal and your career objectives.
- 2) Include why you believe your interest and objectives make you uniquely qualified for this scholarship.

Applicant must provide a list of any Honors, Awards or Distinctions.

Applicant must provide a list of any extracurricular activities and affiliations with other professional organizations.

Applicant must provide a list of any volunteer or community service.

Conditions

Scholarships may be applied only to Appraisal Institute core courses offered by the Atlanta Chapter of the Appraisal Institute and that are provided to qualify an individual for the MAI or SRA designation.

Scholarship money will be paid directly to the course provider. Scholarship money is for course fee only. Scholarship award must be used within the 18 months following its award date.

Only one scholarship may be awarded to any one individual in any one award period. There is a limit of two annual consecutive awards for any individual.

Award recipients must submit written correspondence to the Chapter Executive Director stating his/her intention to attend the course, no later than 30 days before the start date of the intended course.

Applications will be made available February 1. Deadline to submit application is February 28. The scholarships will be awarded on March 15 of each year.

A photo of the Applicant will be requested by the Scholarship Committee for publicity and promotional uses.

A written letter will notify applicant if a scholarship has, or has not been awarded.
